

BORC – MAJOR MILESTONES OF 2021


(AKA CHAIRMAN'S REPORT)





2022 – OUR OBJECTIVES

To continue to run a welcoming, supportive community for amateur riders and horse owners in and around Bicester

- To renew 75% of existing members and attract in 10 % new members (85 total) before end March
- To provide a range of cost effective clinics and ‘have a go’ opportunities that meet the needs of the majority of our members, recognising we have a wide range of interest, abilities and availabilities! ... but to commit to running a minimum of 2 flatwork clinics , 2 jumping clinics a month; one Social event at least every quarter and a summer dressage show, camp and 2 group hacks
- To have at least one team for each Area Qualifier and increase the number of people taking part, encouraging more people to get involved with easy to understand info and supportive training plus to run at least one Area Qualifier for Area 6 ourselves!
- To put on a range of social and non ridden activities which encourage members to interact and identify a range of BORC goods and services which members may wish to purchase.
- To develop a range of income streams that support those who want to ride in teams (by covering the BRC pre entry fees) and give value back / invest for the benefit of the whole membership
- To encourage more members to take part in activities, be it through active participation , supporting or volunteering
- To continue to improve our communications and administration with the aim of becoming a ‘show case’ organisation of a RC !
- To keep the club financially solvent!
