CLASSES

Classes 1-4 and class 6 will be run as single phase. Riders jump round 6-8 fences, and then they go straight into the timed jump-off against the clock without interruption or halting in between rounds. ... In a "single phase" class faults are accumulated in both sections with all riders going through to the timed part of the course against the clock. Starting times will be issued for each competitor and must be strictly adhered too.

Class

- 1. Snowflake stakes max 50cm, single phase Kindly Sponsored by Golden Groomers
- 2. Sleigh Bell stakes max 60cm, single phase Kindly sponsored by Michaela Burke Dressage and Livery
- 3. Christmas Pudding stakes -60/65cm, single phase Kindly sponsored by Cholsey Riding
- **4. Santa stakes 70/75cm**, **single phase** Kindly Sponsored by Country Equestrian
- **5. Reindeer relay Pairs class approx. 80cm** Kindly Sponsored by Country Equestrian

First rider jumps the course, then hands a baton / whip over to second rider who will be waiting in a boxed area. Second rider then completes the course.

Riders can 'rescue' each other in the event of 2 refusals at any one fence. The baton must be exchanged in the event of a rescue. Each rider may only rescue once. After a rescue, the rider must complete the course and then their own round if relevant.

The Round will be judged on total faults and time of both riders.

- 6. Christmas Cracker Stakes- 80/85cm, single phase Kindly Sponsored by Country Equestrian
- 7. Advent accumulator 80cm to 1m (only the joker will be 1m) Kindly Sponsored by Country Equestrian

This competition takes place over eight obstacles which are progressively more difficult. The progressive difficulty is not solely due to the height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track. Points are awarded as follows: One point for obstacle No. 1 cleared, two points for No. 2, three points for No. 3 etc. with total of 36. No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Faults other than knock-downs are penalised as per normal and any of these faults are converted into points and deducted from any jumping points scored.

In the event of equality of points, this competition will also take place directly against the clock. The last obstacle of the course, The Joker, will carry double

points (16 points). If the Joker is knocked down, the points must be deducted from the total. There will be an alternative to the joker which only carries 8 points.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry and to alter the programme.
- 2. The competition is run under BRC SJ Rules 2021
- 3. Competition clothing should ideally be worn
- 4. All competitors' hats must comply with BRC rules
- 5. The Judge's decision is final.
- 6. Back protectors are recommended for show jumping.
- 7. No horse/pony is to compete more than once by the same rider in any one class unless HC.
- 8. All competitors will agree to abide by the rules of the competition.
- 9. Entries will close before the closing date if classes are full.
- 10. Prize giving will take place at the end of each class.
- 11. No refunds will be made unless the show is cancelled
